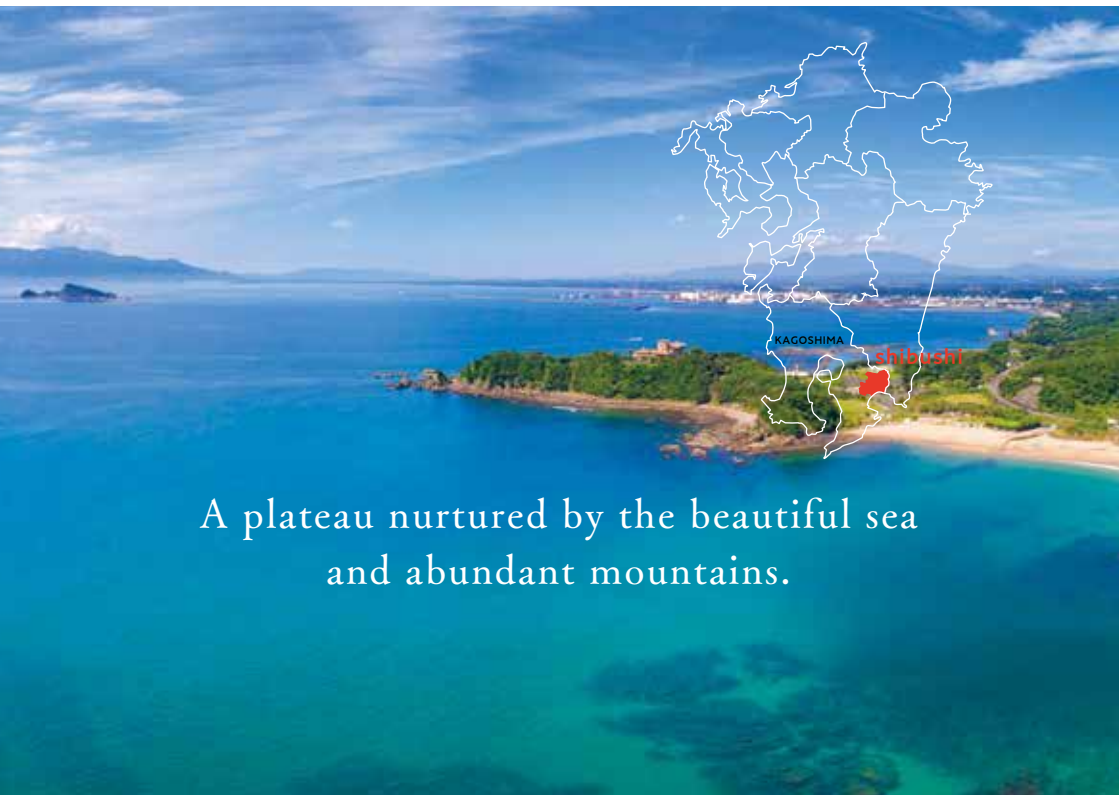

Summer Soba

Shibushi Soba is in Season Even in Summer

While the typical soba harvest season is in November, Shibushi City is also known for its summer soba, which is harvested in early June.

Every year on June 30, during the "Nagoshi no Oharae" purification ritual at Anraku Yamamiya Shrine (→P14), it is customary to serve freshly harvested summer soba after the ceremony.

Additionally, seasonal summer soba dishes appear on the menus of restaurants and specialty shops across Shibushi City—be sure to enjoy this limited-time delicacy!

In addition to set meals, tempura rice bowls, and course meals, their temmusu (tempura rice balls) and fried dumplings are also popular.



Shibushi Shirasu

Shibushi's locally caught shirasu (whitebait) (→ P08) can be enjoyed in various forms, including boiled (kama-age), sun-dried, and simmered in soy sauce (tsukudani). Each one pairs perfectly with rice!



Biroujima Manju

Inspired by Birou Island, which floats in Shibushi Bay, this treat features a buttery biscuit-like outer layer filled with white bean paste infused with Shibushi-grown matcha.



Isakida Manju

A beloved confection in Shibushi since its founding in 1979. It features a perfectly balanced sweet red bean paste rapped in a soft and chewy dough. The tea-flavored version, available only on weekends, is also a popular choice!

Daiji Temple

Founded in 1340, and later recognized in 1444 as one of the Ten Rinzai Temples by the shogunate, this is the foremost Zen temple in Southern Kyushu.

At its peak, Daiji Temple covered an area of around "8 chō shihō", housed 16 branch temples, and served as a center of learning for over 100 Zen monks, making it a significant hub for Buddhist studies in the region.

During the Meiji-era policy of separating Shinto and Buddhism, Kagoshima experienced severe anti-Buddhist destruction, leading to the loss of many historical temple buildings. Daiji Temple was greatly reduced in size, and numerous cultural assets were scattered.

The current Daiji Temple was rebuilt in 1879 by Reverend Hakushū on the site of Hōchi-an, one of its former 16 branch temples.

Even today, the temple preserves many historical books, paintings, and sculptures, attracting visitors from across Japan and abroad for zazen meditation and sutra copying experiences.



The Niō guardian statues stand at the temple gate. The left statue is a Kagoshima Prefecture-designated cultural property, measuring 229 cm in height and 124 cm in width.

Site of Homan Temple

Founded during the Nara period, the temple was destroyed during the Meiji-era anti-Buddhist movement, but later the Kannon Hall was rebuilt. It is believed to bring blessings for safe childbirth, attracting visitors from both inside and outside the prefecture. Every year in April, the temple hosts the "Shaka Matsuri." (→P26)

Anraku Yamamiya Shrine

Founded in 709, the temple is home to a massive camphor tree said to have been planted by Emperor Tenji (626-672). Every year on June 30, the Nagoshi no Oharae, a purification ritual, is held, where Shibushi's summer soba (→P07) is offered, and participants pass through a chino-wa (reed ring).

Site of Shibushi Castle

Shibushi Castle is a collective term for four fortifications: Uchi Castle, Matsuo Castle, Takajo Castle, and Shinjo Castle. It was designated as a national cultural property in 2005, recognized as one of the representative mountain castles of southern Kyushu in the Sengoku period.

Although the exact date of construction is unclear, Shibushi Castle was inhabited during the Muromachi period (1336-1568), a time of turmoil. It was home to various clans, including Lord Kimotsuki, Lord Itô of the Hyûga Clan, and Lord Shimadzu, and gradually expanded in scale, preserving its final form from the Sengoku period.

The Uchi Castle is well-maintained, allowing for a pleasant walk. Visitors can see traces of the dry moats, passes, and baileys. Additionally, in 2023, a CG video titled "Shibushi Castle 1536" was created, based on a restored model of the castle from that era.

Scan the QR code placed at the viewing points on-site to experience an immersive 360-degree video that vividly recreates the scene.

Shibushi Castle has been selected as one of the Continued 100 Top Japanese Castles by the Japan Castle Foundation.

The Uchi Castle, the central mountain castle of Shibushi Castle, has been restored to a 1:200 scale. It features an explanatory video that provides insights into the history of Shibushi Castle and its high defensive capabilities.



Walkthrough

"VR" Shibushi Castle 1536



Available at 5 viewing spots. This VR experience recreates the 1536 battle between the Niiru Clan and the Hôshu Shimadzu Clan in a mountain castle setting. Enjoy the immersive experience, as if you're part of the battle, and the impressive reconstruction of the scene overlaid with the current landscape.

What is "Fumoto"?

During the Edo period, the Satsuma clan set up Tojō (outer castles) throughout the region to defend against external threats, and the samurai residences in these areas became the heart of these defensive zones. In 2019, a collection of 95 cultural properties across 9 cities in Kagoshima Prefecture, including Shibushi Fumoto, was recognized as a Japan Heritage site under the title "The Town Where the Samurai of Satsuma Lived – Walking Through the Samurai Residences 'Fumoto'".

Shibushi Fumoto

This Fumoto, which evolved from a medieval samurai village, retained its original structure through to the early modern period.

Nestled in a valley surrounded by Shibushi Castle, it is home to samurai gates, stone walls, beautiful gardens, and street known as Baba (horse-riding paths).

The spring water within Fumoto is renowned as a famous water source, and even today, many people visit to collect the water.

Amamizu Garden



A tsukiyama kare-sansui style garden, incorporating Shibushi Castle (Uchi Castle) as a borrowed landscape. It is believed to have been created in the mid-Edo period (1681~1780), though the identity of the garden's designer remains unknown.

Hirayama Garden



A three-dimensional landscape garden utilizing rock beds, believed to have been created in the early Edo period (1603-1690) by the head priest of Ishimine Temple.

Kiyomizu Garden



The garden is characterized by stone walls made of river stones after passing through the gate. Created in the mid-Edo (1681-1780) period by a samurai who resided in Shibushi Fumoto, it follows the tsukiyama kare-sansui landscape garden style.

A three-dimensional garden that utilizes the natural slope, with sharp angles cut from rock beds. Created by a samurai who lived in Shibushi Fumoto, it follows the tsukiyama kare-sansui (landscape garden) style.

Fukuyama Garden



A tsukiyama kare-sansui (landscape garden) style garden that uses Hōmanji Temple and the mountain range behind it as a borrowed landscape. In 2024, preservation and repairs of the building were completed, making it possible to tour the grounds. Additionally, visitors can experience mini archery with the Shihan-mato target (¥300 per session).

Thanks to the efforts of preservation volunteers, the C58 112 steam locomotive, still retains the appearance it had during its active days.



Shibushi Station, the terminus of the Nichinan Line, was once a major terminal where the Shibushi Line and Osumi Line converged. After the Shibushi Line and Osumi Line were discontinued in 1987, the former engine depot was converted into the Railway Memorial Park in 1996 to preserve its history for future generations.

The park houses several preserved railway vehicles, including the C58 112 steam locomotive, the Yo 8951 freight car, and the Kiha 52 130 diesel car, all evoking the atmosphere of the past. During the winter months, the park is beautifully illuminated, making it a popular illumination spot.
